


Hard Problem Budget













- Lacking language understanding
- Hard to find relevant sources (deep/dark web), content highly volatile
- Need to prioritize what threats to focus on

\rightarrow Goal is to make the human analyst >10x more efficient





- Open web high volume, low-to-high value
 - Mainstream media, blogs, social media, cyber threat intel sources
 - Paste sites
 - Code repositories
 - Dark web sites
 - Underground forums

Closed/Dark web – small volume, very high value


- Technical sources







- Skate to where the puck will be... (aka "bleeding edge" :-)
- Dare to explore early on, when it's cheap focus when you "strike gold" – then expand

- You don't need to "innovate everything"




Alligator vs. Elephant
